Leadership: When we read Scripture, we see tales of men and women who were called empowered and enabled to lead. They were imperfect, because like you and me they were growing in God's grace to become the leaders God was calling them to be. There has to be room for everyone who serves in ministry to mature and become what God sees in them that we might not see.

Consider what Paul says about who God chooses...

26 Brothers, think of what you were when you were called. Not many of you were wise by human standards; not many were influential; not many were of noble birth. 27 But God chose the foolish things of the world to shame the wise; God chose the weak things of the world to shame the strong. 28 He chose the lowly things of this world and the despised things--and the things that are not--to nullify the things that are, 29 so that no one may boast before him. 30 It is because of him that you are in Christ Jesus, who has become for us wisdom from God--that is, our righteousness, holiness and redemption.

~ 1 Corinthians 1:26 - 30

Like most churches, the church in Corinth needed some guidance, correcting, and leading in some areas where they were missing the mark. There were those who were making communion something so much less than what God intended it to be, they were not taking an honest look at the life that they were living and the sin they needed to confess before partaking of the Lord's Supper. There was disunity in the church as some claimed to follow Paul, while another claimed to follow Cephas, and still another said they followed Apollos, while another contended that they followed Christ (1 Cor. 1:10 – 12). How I pray each of us are following Jesus.

Because church can get messy, I want to share with you some thoughts. As we move forward with the construction of our new church building know that your leaders are often stepping out of their comfort zone, trusting God, and seeking to do this thing God is
