

Different: The birth of Christ the promised Messiah meant things were going to be different. God was going to do something new as He established a new and better covenant. There was going to be a significant change in basic assumptions as so much of what the people were accustomed to would be changed.

During Jesus' ministry people recognized that He was different. He taught like no other taught. He worked miracles that no one else could do. He confronted hypocrisy in the religious pharisees lives. while eating and talking with "sinners". Some of God's people were anticipating the Messiah, but He was different than what they had expected.

There was so much that Jesus was making new and different. The message He preached was for everyone, even the Gentiles. During His last meal with His disciples. He instituted communion to replace the Passover meal. Because of Jesus things would be different. Then of course Jesus did the most radically different of things when He laid down His life for a world of lost sinners, and He became the atoning sacrifice for our sins. His sacrifice meant we are not required to sacrifice animals to atone for our sin.

8 First he said, "Sacrifices and offerings, burnt offerings and sin offerings you did not desire, nor were you pleased with them" (although the law required them to be made). 9 Then he said, "Here I am, I have come to do your will." He sets aside the first to establish the second. 10 And by that will, we have been made holy through the sacrifice of the body of Jesus Christ once for all. 11 Day after day every priest stands and performs his religious duties; again and again he offers the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins. 12 But when this priest had offered for all time one sacrifice for sins, he sat down at the right hand of God. 13 Since that time he waits for his enemies to be made his footstool, 14 because by one sacrifice he has made perfect forever those who are being made holy. ~ Hebrews 10:8 – 14


